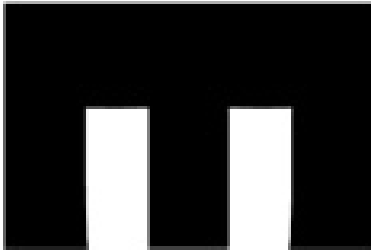
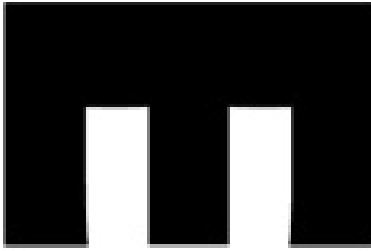

Moorfields is world renowned for having the top specialists and equipment for diagnosing and treating eye problems.

The Electrodiagnostic department uses Faraday caged rooms and sensitive amplifiers (some made in house) to detect when the eye reacts to optical stimuli. This allows them to localise problems with the retina and visual cortex, and even to determine neurophysical problems.
